


## Pathways after GCSE explained



Once you have completed your **GCSEs** you'll have your **level 2 qualifications** under your belt (well done!)

After this, during year 12 and 13, you'll be studying for level 3 qualifications. These can be:

- Advanced apprenticeships
- BTEX Cert/Diplomas
- A Levels
- T Levels

At 18, you'll leave school and begin working or continue to study using the following paths:

- A level 4 art foundation course (which leads onto an arts based 3 year degree course)
- Honour's degree (level 6)
- Degree apprenticeships (please see the apprenticeships explained link for more information on this (Level 6)
