

### What To Say To An Employer

- Say "Hello" & introduce yourself; e.g. "My name is Claire Smith and I am a student at Chestnut Grove Academy"
- Explain the purpose of your visit/call; e.g. "I wanted to find out if you accept students for work experience?"
- From here you just need to listen carefully and answer the questions posed to you by the employer.
