In order to support your child's learning please ensure that your child:

- Has the revision materials needed for each subject
- Manages their time effectively; e.g. ensuring revision and homework are completed, limit use of computer games, watching TV and time spent on mobile devices
- Eats healthily in the run up to and during exams
- Gets plenty of sleep
- Brings a reusable bottle of water to exams

Students will be expected to follow the exam code of conduct during this period. For all exams students are expected to:

- Line up in class groups outside the classroom/hall
- Wear correct school uniform at all times
- Enter in silence and remain in silence throughout the exam
- Bring the correct equipment (pen, pencil, ruler, mathematical set, calculator) in a clear pencil case
- Put their hand up for a question or query
- Face the front at all times
- Start and complete the exam as instructed

Any misconduct in exams will result in the subject teacher contacting home and a one hour detention with the Head of Department after school to complete the exam.

The results of these exams will give students, parents and carers and teachers the ability to review your child's progress in the part of the GCSE course they have studied in Year 10.
